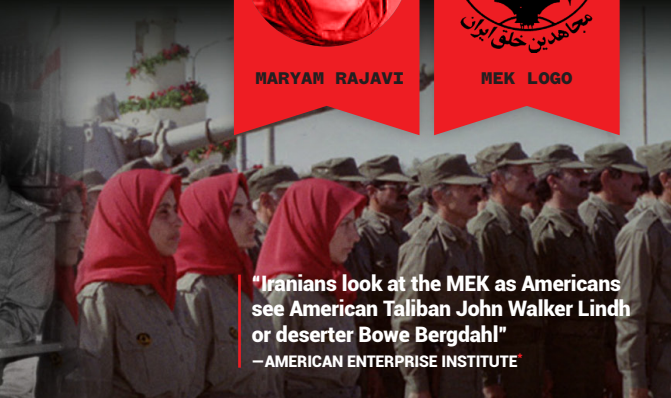

The MEK is a cult that abuses its members.

The organization is under the absolute control of Maryam Rajavi, who is considered by members to be Iran's unelected "President-elect". The group's practices are widely described as cult-like and are reported to include the following:

FORCED DIVORCE

Former members testified that upon entry into the organization, all marriages were terminated. Wedding bands were confiscated and members were told that they did not have the right to marry until the Islamic Republic was overthrown¹.

FORCED STERILIZATION

According to former members, some female members of the MEK were forced to receive hysterectomies¹.

HUMAN RIGHTS ABUSES

Former members of the MEK have repeatedly reported being subjected to physical and psychological torture, including beatings, electrocution, and sleep deprivation².

SEXUAL ABUSE & RAPE

Former female members have reported that they were forced to perform sexual acts on the cult's former leader, Massoud Rajavi¹⁴. Survivors report that this sexual abuse was organized by Maryam Rajavi¹.

FAMILY SEPERATION & ISOLATION

Former members accuse the group of separating children from their parents while brainwashing them and keeping them from contacting the outside world¹⁴.

The MEK aided Saddam Hussein in his war against Iran and in his massacre of Iraqi Kurds.

The MEK was based in Iraq during Saddam Hussein's dictatorship and openly aided and abetted in his oppression of Iraqi Kurds and in his war against Iran³. The MEK was funded and armed by Saddam Hussein and helped him maintain power through atrocities including, but not limited to³:

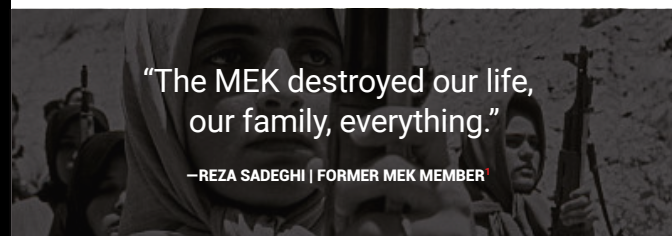
Conducting summary executions and torture of Iraqi civilians and Iranian PoWs

Using child soldiers in combat operations⁴

Taking their own members captive for speaking out against the MEK's actions²

Invading Iran from their bases in Iraq and killing Iranian soldiers and civilians⁵

Attacking civilian targets, including schools and hospitals, resulting in significant casualties⁵

THE MEK'S SECRETIVE CAMP "ASHRAF 3"

The most devoted MEK members live at the "Ashraf 3" compound in Albania after being moved from post-Saddam Iraq. While the members live in meager conditions and partake in regular propaganda rallies, their leaders are reported to live luxurious lives in France.

The MEK was formally recognized as a Foreign Terrorist Organization (FTO) by the US State Department from October 8th, 1997 until September 28th, 2012¹⁰

In 2012, the MEK paid \$1.5 million total for three lobbying firms to delist the MEK from the FTO list: DLA Piper; Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld; and DiGenova & Toensing¹¹

The MEK uses many front organizations and political groups

These front and affiliated groups are often used in an attempt to obscure the MEK's involvement in order to secure relationships with high level American political leaders.



NATIONAL COUNCIL OF RESISTANCE OF IRAN (NCRI)— U.S. REPRESENTATIVE OFFICE

The NCRI claims to be an umbrella organization of Iranian opposition groups but in reality is run by the MEK and Maryam Rajavi¹². The US Representative Office serves as a liaison between the NCRI and American policymakers and organizations.



ORGANIZATION OF IRANIAN AMERICAN COMMUNITIES (OIAC)

A coalition of Iranian-American organizations that appears to be a front for Maryam Rajavi and the MEK¹³. Below are specific examples of these groups:

How can I support the people of Iran?

DO NOT engage with the MEK, the NCRI, or OIAC.

DO NOT SUPPORT H.RES. 100 - AN MEK PROPAGANDA BILL.

While at first glance, the MEK-proposed H.Res. 100 may appear to support the Iranian people, it instead promotes the MEK's political agenda. The resolution reads, in part:

"...support for the opposition leader Mrs. Maryam Rajavi's 10-point plan for the future of Iran..."

The resolution also endorses a specific form of government for Iran, whereas most Iranians and Iranian-Americans believe in the Iranian people's right to choose their future form of government for themselves in a national referendum.

CO-SPONSOR H.R. 589 (MAHSA ACT) also known as the *Mahsa Amini Human Rights and Security Accountability Act (MAHSA Act)*.

The bipartisan MAHSA Act uses existing sanctions to designate Iran's Supreme Leader and President for human rights violations. It is the first human rights legislation on Iran that has gained the support of the majority of Iranian-Americans.
